By singing up to and joining KM United Youth FC you agree to accept and understand the followings terms: -

Medical & Welfare

- You agree to provide as much information as possible in relation to any medical, welfare, communication of medicine requirements for your player and discuss the details with the relevant team coaches. Including how you/your player manages them
- All medicines must always be in a named bag with the player
- Standard glasses must not be used for football with only football specific Sports
 Glasses to be used to participate in training and matches
- The club must be informed if your player wears contact lenses for football
- If your player is injured whilst playing football/travelling to and from football events and you cannot be contacted, you hereby give consent for your player/child to be given any medical attention they need
- It is your responsibility to arrange safe and punctual travel for your player to and from football training and matches

Membership & Fees

- You consent to your player being registered with KM United Youth FC, Devon FA, and the League for the duration of KM United Membership
- The club must be informed if you or your player decides to leave, and you agree to return match kit if your player leaves the club
- Fees must be paid promptly via Spond without the club volunteers having to chase you for payment
- Payment details in Spond must be kept up to date to ensure monthly payments can be completed
- Nonpayment of fees will be interpreted as your decision that you player wishes to leave the club
- Membership fee refunds are only given in exceptional circumstances and would be proportionate to costs incurred

Behaviour, Code of Conduct & Club Policies

- You confirm that you have read the KM United Codes of Conduct & Policies and will ensure that you, your player, all members of family and friends will abide by it. The Code of Conduct can be viewed

- It is your responsibility to ensure that anyone providing care to your player is aware of all the club & team specific protocols and guidelines regarding behaviour and safeguarding. Details can be found here:- https://www.kmunitedfc.net/clubpolicies
- If the club deems anyone's behaviour to be inappropriate and not in line with club policies and code of conduct then they will be asked to leave the club

Club Kit & Appropriate attire

- If your player does not have suitable attire, footwear, shin pads, a drink or their essential medication they are not allowed to take part in training sessions or matches
- You agree to pay for replacement match kit or training kit if your player loses or damages it
- You agree to return match kit if your child leaves the club

Matches & Game time

 You accept that your player will not play every match or every minute of matches and that coaches manage match invites and game time throughout matches to ensure each player has the chance to develop and play at a level and pace suitable to them

Use of information

- It is your responsibility to keep the information used in the sign up or membership renewal process and stored within Spond up to date, and inform the Club directly of any changes to personal details
- You consent to KM United Youth Football Club using the data you have provided in the sign up and membership renewal process for the purposes of registering your player with KM United, the League and the FA. Also, for the purposes of running the club, contacting you with news and information relating to the club. *Your data is not shared with any organisation or individual other than those above. Access to the data within KM United is restricted to the appropriate coaches and committee members only.

Coaches & Volunteers expectations

 If you are a coach, coaching assistant, parent helper, volunteer or member of the committee you have read and understand the KM United & FA Guidance and protocols required to ensure a safe as possible football environment. You understand what is expected, will follow the guidance and ensure adherence to the policies documented. Including but not limited to the need for DBS checks, safeguarding & first aid certification.

Photograph & Video Conditions

- KM Utd players may be photographed and/or videoed during training or matches, solely for the purposes of training, match analysis or publicity by KM United FC or its sponsors e.g. website, leaflets, social media, newspaper articles.
- Photos and video may be published on the KM Utd closed and restricted facebook page
- Some teams use a Veo Camera to record fixtures or training to enhance the football learning and coaching experience.
- Note: Children are never named or individually identified in any publicity.
- Photography is safe and respectful.
- Individuals must not post pictures or videos of KM Utd players on the open internet or open social media platforms
